Approval of Agenda

Motion by Supervisor Rasmussen to approve the agenda to be discussed in any order, second by Supervisor Eliason. Vote: Unanimous/Motion carried.

Consent Agenda

Nuisance Wildlife

Pro Clean Dishwasher Contract

Motion to accept proposal submitted by Pro Clean by Supervisor Rasmussen, second by Supervisor Eliason. Vote: Unanimous/Motion carried.

Scoreboard Policy/Protocol

Motion to table discussion and add scoreboard purchase to next agenda by Supervisor Rasmussen. Second by Supervisor Eliason. Vote: Unanimous/Motion carried.

TextMyGov

Motion by Supervisor Rasmussen (per committee recommendation) to enter into agreement with TextMyGov, second by Supervisor Eliason. Vote: Unanimous. Motion carried.

Workhorse Implementation

Chair Postuchow updated the board on implementation progress. Supervisor Rasmussen will be new contact for Workhorse communication. July 1st is the set implementation date.

Sale of Snowbulance

Motion to sell EMS snowbulance (approved at electors meeting) by Supervisor Eliason, second by Chair Postuchow.. Vote: 2/3 in favor. Supervisor Rasmussen recused himself. Motion carried.
