

## Plum Lake Town Board Meeting Minutes

May 12, 2026

Approved June 9, 2026

**Open Meeting Verification:** The meeting was duly called by Chair Postuchow at 6:00pm with the notice posted at the EMS Building in Sayner, the US Sayner Post Office, and notice was given to the Vilas County News-Review, The Lakeland Times, WRJO, WERL, as well as posted on the Town of Plum Lake website.

**Roll Call:** Chair Postuchow, Supervisor Eliason, Supervisor Rasmussen, Treasurer Klager, Clerk Arnold, Deb Seeger, Tom Oracki, John Richter, George Lannert, Sheehan Donoghue, Shane Gauger, Gary Schmidt, Trever Kalkofen, Helen Bryner, Barb Maines, Terry Monroe, Andy Smith, Chuck Rasmussen and Joan Kazda were in attendance.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all.

**Citizen Comments:** Gary Schmidt reported on Highway G Landfill as a member of the Landfill Venture Group Board. The landfill is currently a transfer station. Decisions need to be made about building a new cell. Recycling is not being taken any longer because the landfill had to pay to get rid of the recycling.

Other Citizen comments from Sheehan Donoghue, Terry Monroe, John Richter and George Lannert on Agenda Item number 2(b)Updating Ordinance 2024-003 (ATV-UTV).

**Approval of Agenda:** Motion by Supervisor Eliason to approve the agenda to be discussed in any order. Seconded by Supervisor Rasmussen. Vote: Unanimous/Carried

#### 1. Acceptance of Donation of Christmas Tree

The Christmas tree is being donated to the town by Allen and Lisa Miles for possible use in the new Community Center. Discussion regarding where it might be used and stored. Decision by board to accept the donated tree and if it is not feasible to use by the town, it will be donated to another entity

#### 2. Approve updates to Ordinance 2024-003 (ATV/UTV)

- a) **Camp 2 & Tower Rd Residents Request for snow removal and maintenance:**

Discussion of the roads being snowmobile trails during the winter. Chair Postuchow will contact residents making the request to inform them that the roads will continue to be maintained according to the current schedule.

**b) Extending ATV/UTV access on Golf Course Rd at request of a resident:**

Comments from John Richter, George Lannert, Terry Monroe and Sheehan Donoghue expressing opposition to allowing access to ATVs to the Plum Lake Golf Course and concern for setting precedent for continuing to grant further access.

Discussion regarding allowing residents access to ATV/UTV routes as they request it.

Motion by Supervisor Rasmussen to move the “No ATV/UTV Use” sign from Stern Street to the driveway of 8600 Golf Course Rd. Seconded by Chair Postuchow. Vote:

Unanimous/Motion carried.

**5. Opening of Bids for Lake Street Road Project:**

Bids were opened for the Lake Street Road Project from Northeast Asphalt and Pitlik and Wick. The lowest responsible bidder was determined to be Pitlik and Wick.

Motion by Supervisor Rasmussen to accept the proposal from Pitlik and Wick for the Lake Street Road Project. Second by Supervisor Eliason. Vote: Unanimous/Motion carried.

**6. Action Regarding LaMarre Sayner Cemetery Site:**

Motion by Supervisor Eliason to move ownership of Site 87A to Site 126D in the Sayner Cemetery for Craig and Marlene LaMarre and to refund the Vilas County Register of Deeds filing fee. Second by Supervisor Rasmussen.

Vote: Unanimous/Motion carried.

**3. Approval of Tele-Med Cart without RFP pursuant to Town Procurement Policy:**

Discussion was held regarding authorization for issuance of Requests for Proposals for eligible purchases for the new Community Center FFP Committee. Motion by Supervisor Rasmussen to authorize the Community Center FFP Committee to issue and approve RFPs for eligible purchases related to the Community Center FFP Project. Seconded by Supervisor Eliason. Vote: Unanimous/Motion carried.

**4. Approval of Financial Institution for Loan Authorized by the Electors at Annual Meeting and approval to sign loan documents:**

Motion by Chair Postuchow to sign a resolution to allow the Town Board to use the most responsible financial institution for loans authorized by the town electorate. Seconded by Supervisor Rasmussen. Vote: Unanimous/Motion Carried.

**a) Approval to sign documents**

Motion by Chair Postuchow to allow all members of the Town Board to sign loan documents. Seconded by Supervisor Rasmussen. Vote: Unanimous/Motion carried.
