Ordinance 2023-003

(Replaces Ordinance 2017-001)

Ordinance for Issuance of Provisional Operators' License

SECTION I: TITLE AND PURPOSE

This ordinance is entitled the Town of Plum Lake Ordinance for Issuance of Provisional Operators' License. The purpose of this ordinance is to provide for issuance, on a provisional basis (during the interim period between application and the next scheduled Town Board meeting), of a license for the service or sale of alcoholic beverages. A provisional license may be issued under the following circumstances:

- A. To those persons with a clear background check, and;
- B. Proof of completion of the Responsible Beverage Server Course or proof that they have held an operators' license within the past two years.

SECTION II: AUTHORITY

The Town Board of the Town of Plum Lake, Vilas County, Wisconsin, has the authority under Wis. Stats. 125.17(5)(a)1, to adopt an ordinance to issue provisional operators' license.

SECTION III: ELIGIBILITY

A person who has applied for an operator's license may apply for a provisional operator's license provided the applicant is 18 years of age and has provided proof of enrollment in or completion of the Responsible Beverage Training Course required under s. 125.17(6) Wis. Stats. Applicants must complete a license application. Any and all arrests and convictions of the applicant shall be disclosed on the application. Failure to disclose arrests and convictions will result in license denial.

SECTION IV: APPLICATION

Application for a provisional operator's license shall be made to the town clerk on such form designated by the clerk and shall be accompanied by a fee set forth in the Fee Schedule.

SECTION V: STANDARD

No provisional operator's license shall be granted if the applicant has been denied an operator's license by the town board; the applicant has provided false information on their application; or if the applicant, pursuant to s. 111.321, 111.322, and 111.225, Wis. Stats., has an arrest or conviction records substantially related to the alcohol licensing activity.

SECTION VI: TERM

The provisional operators' license shall be effective for sixty (60) days from the date of issuance, or when a regular operator's license is authorized by the town board, whichever is sooner. In no case shall the provisional

operator's license by effective for more than sixty (60) days after issuance. The issuance date, final date of validity, or both shall be shown on the license when issued.

SECTION VII: ISSUANCE

In addition to the Town Board, the Town Clerk is authorized to issue such a license as provided for in this Ordinance.

SECTION VIII: FEES

A fee, determined by the Town Board, but not to exceed limits as defined in s. 125.17(5)(c), Wis. Stats., and according to the Fee Schedule, is required to be paid with the initial application and background check submittal.

SECTION IX: REVOCATION

The Town Clerk shall:

- A. Immediately revoke the provisional operator's license if the holder fails to successfully complete the responsible beverage server course required under s. 125.17(6), Wis. Stats.
- B. Immediately revoke the provisional operator's license if it is discovered that the holder of the license made a false statement on the application, which may have affected the decision on whether to issue a provisional license, including but not limited to past crimes or arrests.
- C. Revoke the provisional operator's license if the town board denies the applicant's application for an operator's license.
- D. Revoke the provisional operator's license if the town board discovers that the operator license issued by another Wisconsin municipality is not valid.

Revocation of the provisional operator's license shall become effective upon the mailing of the notice of revocation by the town clerk. Any notice mailed in this ordinance is sufficient if mailed via first class mail to the last known address of the licensee, in an envelope containing the return address of the town clerk.

Ordinance #2017-001 will be repealed and replaced with this Ordinance.
