It will still need to be inspected to be sure it meets all the codes. Vilas County has the final say. The Town of Plum Lake has no restrictions against mobil homes. Chairman Maines said he saw no reason to deny this request.

Supervisor Rasmussen made a motion to support the CUP application to put a mobil home on the property of Clifford and Elke Knapp, seconded by Chairman Maines, carried.
